Our numbers are only statistics but each number represents people who without the help of the food bank would go hungry! Many times people, including ourselves, ask how so many people would manage without this support.

#### SMALLER IS BETTER!

It is often economical to buy extra large bags, boxes, tins and bottles of items so larger is better when we buy for ourselves! However in the food bank this is not always the case for us. We do not open and share out large bags of teabags or pasta for example so for us Smaller is Better otherwise it means we have to store large items until an appropriate large family needs our support.
